A part-time, paid bar manager is employed on commercial terms but overseen by an elected club member. All labour for haulage activities is provided by club volunteers.

Minor maintenance is undertaken by club volunteers who are reimbursed at cost for their expenses. More significant maintenance is undertaken by paid trade contractors.

Members participate in working bees twice a year.

Statement of Accounting Policies

"How did we do our accounting?"

Basis of Preparation

The Club has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The Club is GST registered and returns GST on a payments basis.

The financial statements have been prepared on a Goods and Services Tax exclusive basis, with the exception of accounts payable and accounts receivable. GST balances in the financial statements are disclosed on an accrual basis.

Income Tax

The Club is exempt from New Zealand income tax being a club which promotes amateur sports in accordance with section CW 46 of the Income Tax Act 2007 and having fully complied with all statutory conditions for this exemption.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 12 months or less.

Property, plant and Equipment

Items of property, plant and equipment are stated at cost, less accumulated depreciation and any impairment losses. Any donated assets are recorded at their fair value at the date of acquisition.

Fixed assets are depreciated using the diminishing value method.

A copy of the full fixed assets register setting out depreciation rates applied is included in Note 13 to these accounts.

Impairment of assets

Property, plant and equipment are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable through use or sale. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount. Impairment losses are recognised in the statement of financial performance.

Investments

Short-term deposits have maturities between three months and one year. At balance date the Club assesses whether there is any objective evidence that an investment is impaired. Any impairment loss is recorded as an expense in the Statement of Financial Performance.

Inventories

Club bar stock, burgees and apparel held for sale are measured at the lower of average cost and net realisable value. Any write down of inventories is recognised in the statement of financial performance. Cost is determined on an average basis.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise the balances in the current account, bar float and un-deposited funds. Deposits are included when they have a maturity of three months or less from the date of acquisition.
